

## **SYRACUSE: BY THE NUMBERS Eviction**

Eviction case data provided by the Volunteer Lawyers Project of Onondaga County (OnVLP). Data is from October 17, 2012 - January 16, 2017 and only contains eviction cases for which OnVLP provided legal representation. These numbers are most likely a large underestimate of total eviction in Syracuse.



5,500 - 7,000 annual eviction cases.

8,764 - 11,254 individuals evicted annually.





**61.2%** of housing units are renter-occupied. **54.5%** of Syracuse residents live in these rental units.


**57.4%** of renters in Syracuse are housing cost burdened, with only **8.5%** of housing units subsidized to be affordable.




OnVLP Evictions by Percentage of Individuals Cost Burdened in Syracuse, NY 2013 - 2016










Percent of Children Under 17 Living in a Different House Less Than A Year Ago by Census Tract, City of Syracuse (ACS 2011-2015)
